Pleasant Valley Home Built During 1700's



"Old Kentuck" as this home is called, was built before the Revolution. Asher Holmes(who captured a frigate in what is now Deal Lake during the revolt, wrote letters to his young bride at this house. These letters are still in existence. The pre-Revolutionary part of this house is the small wing at the right. The larger section was constructed in 1830. The house contains 11 rooms. Four of the six fireplaces are open. The other two have appertures for stoves. No structural changes have been made in the the house and it is furnished with pieces of the period. (Press Photo)
